### Newsletter 16 23th May 2021 Pentecost Sunday

Dear Parishioners

Ka nui te mihi ki a kōutou mō tēnei rā o te Petekoha! Pentecost greetings to all.

We sometimes refer to the feast of Pentecost as the birthday of the Church. The coming alive of the first disciples as they met the Risen Christ (which we have been celebrating over these 7 weeks since Easter) and which is particularly symbolized at Pentecost is indeed the Church coming to birth.

In that sense over Eastertime we mark a birth 'process'. We hear the stories of the encounters of the first disciples with the Risen Jesus – by his tomb, in the Upper Room, on the road to Emmaus, etc – and the stories in the Acts of the Apostles about how the Spirit inspired the early Church communities in Antioch, Ephesus, Corinth and so on.

God's Spirit is alive and speaking to us constantly. The little Ignatian retreat day held last week in the parish's community room in Blenheim was an experience of specifically listening to that spirit. But it is not just on retreat days that we listen for that call, because we can experience God's presence each day in our family life, in our workplace, in daily events, in creation, in our children, in fact in any moment because God is everywhere.

Today we also say au revoir, to Fr Pat. He has served generously and well here in the parish in the midst of various challenging events over these last years. Cardinal John has already expressed his gratitude to Fr Pat but I would like to reiterate that on behalf of the Archdiocese as I come here to spend some weeks helping till Fr Giltus can arrive.
