Newsletter 17, 19th May 2024 Pentecost

The Finance and Property Committee and Steering Group have been involved for sometime with looking at Buildings, Property and Facilities within our Parish. This project is large and ongoing taking some time to complete. One of the largest tasks (and possibly the costliest!) is to evaluate, and remediate the earthquake risk of St Marys Church in Blenheim. As several of our Parishioner's know the Church is a Heritage listed Building -Category 1.- "A Building of National Significance". Therefore, we are under Heritage New Zealand's control and administration for any proposed work. Another issue is the St Marys' School & Pre-school cannot use the Church during school time for School/Class masses as it is deemed unsafe for the children to enter. This Heritage listing is a very challenging aspect and requires a lot of approvals and submissions for remedial work involving Heritage Architects and Engineers.

The church being a focal point in our parish along with all our other church's making up Star of the Sea Parish - we need to address this issue. The committee after initial discussions with Heritage NZ, have engaged Dunning Thornton Consulting Structural Engineers in Wellington (who completed seismic retrofit of St Johns and Old St Paul's Wellington - similar buildings in structure/era) to assist. An initial visit has been undertaken and it was recommended that a DSA (Detailed Seismic assessment) be undertaken. This work is about to start and will take approx. 6 to 8 months.

As this Sunday is Pentecost, we remember our forefathers who invested to build our now merged parish with many buildings and history which has blessed us all in the holy spirit as we continue their work.

Your patience and understanding of the situation is greatly appreciated and as a Parish effects us all. Again, the Committee are very grateful for all the support, both financial and physical, that we receive and we will continue to update as more information comes to hand.
