## Newsletter 20, 9th June 2024 10th Sunday of Ordinary Time

Today's reading highlights the rough parts of Jesus ministry. It is easy to think that everything went well for him but this gospel passage emphasizes the difficulties he laboured under. Jesus was the equivalent of a present day rock star and chaos seemed to follow him as people who were desperate for a glimpse of him jostled and fought to be close. From his base in Capharnaum as he travelled through Galilee with his twelve companions receiving the same rapturous welcome wherever he went, he was calling people into a spiritual family, a new community. When Jesus left Nazareth he "lost" his natural family, but gained another family – the family of his disciples. Those who hear and do the will of God are now Jesus brothers and sisters and mother. Family, cultural or racial ties don't necessarily create a community; belief in Jesus and the practice of God's will are what create community. Jesus gives us an example of faithfulness. With his example to inspire us, and his grace to strengthen us, we too can be faithful to our vocation as his disciples, and work together for the good of all. - Belinda V
