Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

8 September commemorates the birth day of Mary, and is the feast day that we were given by Cardinal John Dew in 2016 when the parishes of Kaikoura, Picton and Blenheim were amalgamated to become Star of the Sea Parish. There are only three birthdays on the liturgical calendar: Mary, Jesus, and John the Baptist. Usually, it is the custom to celebrate the feast day of a saint on the date of their death as that marks their "birth" into everlasting life. Mary, however, entered the world sinless. She was born to be the mother of the Saviour of the world. And, just as Jesus was to be the **perfect** expression of God's love, so she was the foreshadowing of God's great love for us. Through Mary comes Christ, the Light of the World and our Saviour. Throughout the centuries, the Church has turned to Mary, the Mother of God and many forms of devotion have developed that help bring us closer to her Son. The Church honours her as the Mother of God, looks to her as a model of perfect discipleship, and asks for her prayers to God on our behalf.
