This Sunday is set aside to commemorate and celebrate the life, spirituality, and good works of Venerable Meri Hohepa Suzanne Aubert, and the Sisters of Compassion are thankful to the New Zealand Catholic Bishops Conference for making this day part of the Aotearoa New Zealand National Liturgy Calendar. Born in Lyons France in 1835, Meri Höhepa Suzanne Aubert came to New Zealand with Bishop Pompallier and worked among the Maori in Auckland and Hawke Bay before journeying up the Whanganui River to Hiruharama to help re-establish the Catholic Mission. She was confronted by challenges, disappointments, rebuffs, but also times of happiness and joy just like most people, and today the Sister community and volunteers carrying on her work in her name continue to serve the marginalised and those society ignores with a real 'hands' on' approach which is love in action. This special day enables the people of Aotearoa New Zealand to continue to learn about this amazing woman of our time, and why we continue to pray for her beatification.
