### Living Out the Spirit of Lent - Learning Through Empathy and Service

The Third Sunday of Lent invites us to reflect on themes of renewal, compassion, and spiritual growth — themes beautifully reflected in the recent learning experience, at St Mary's School, between Room 7 and Room 1A. Lent encourages us to open our hearts to others and extend God's love through acts of kindness and service. The students' exploration of empathy through the life and work of Suzanne Aubert embodies these Lenten values in a meaningful and practical way.

Suzanne Aubert's legacy of compassion — sharing food, welcoming the lonely, and offering support — mirrors the Lenten call to serve others and deepen our connection with God.
